

The age distribution of SosyalBen Volunteers of age 18-25 with 82 % woman and 18 % men is shown below:




EDUCATION

The community volunteers train in 86 different departments at 41 universities. 97% of all the volunteers are undergraduate students, whereas 2% are associate degree and 1% graduate students.

Social science students compose 71 % of the SosyalBen volunteers; 29 % study and technical disciplines.

84 % of the universities are public, whereas 16 % is private.
